Forensic Science Day



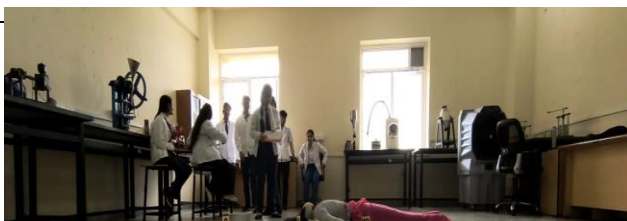
About Events
