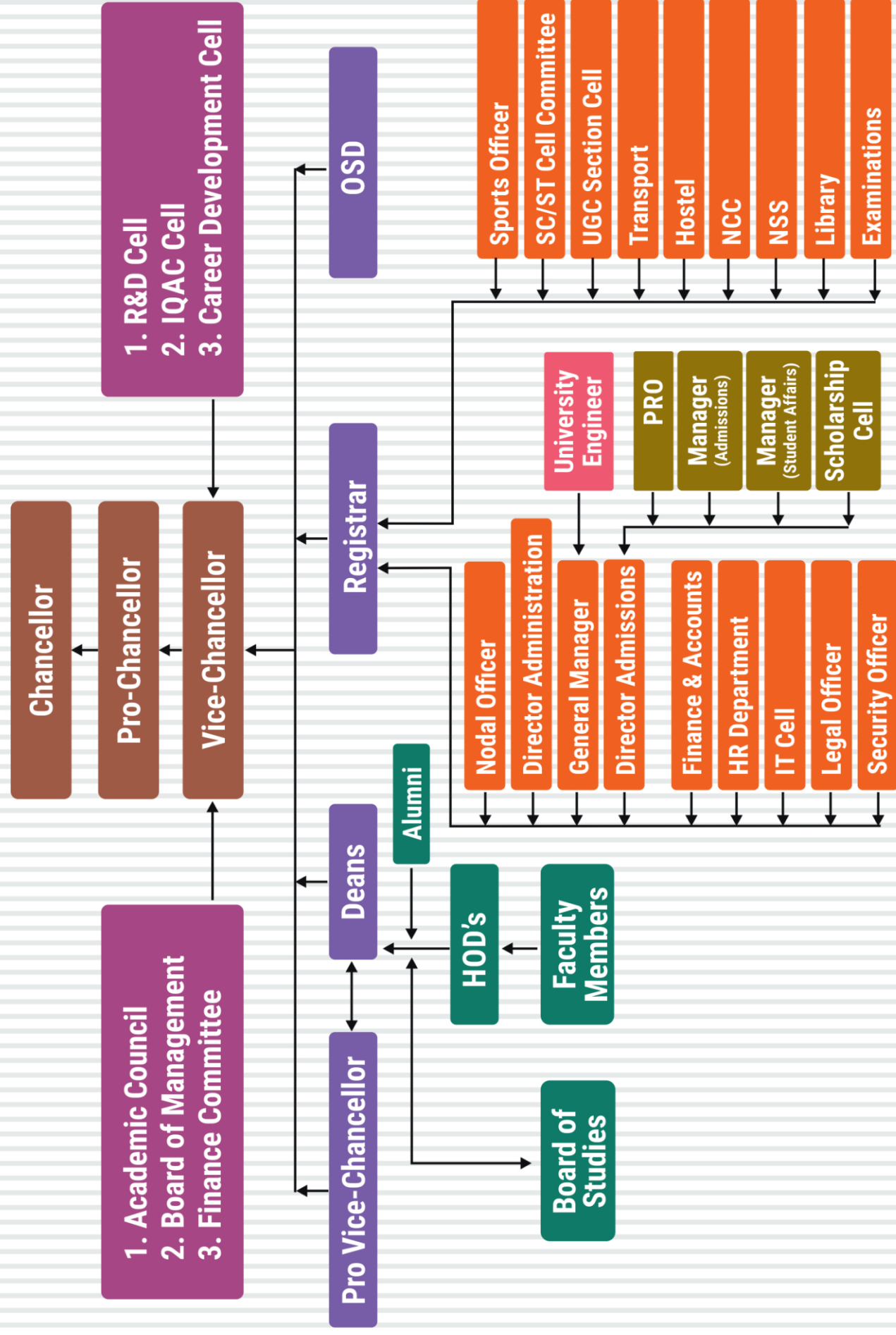

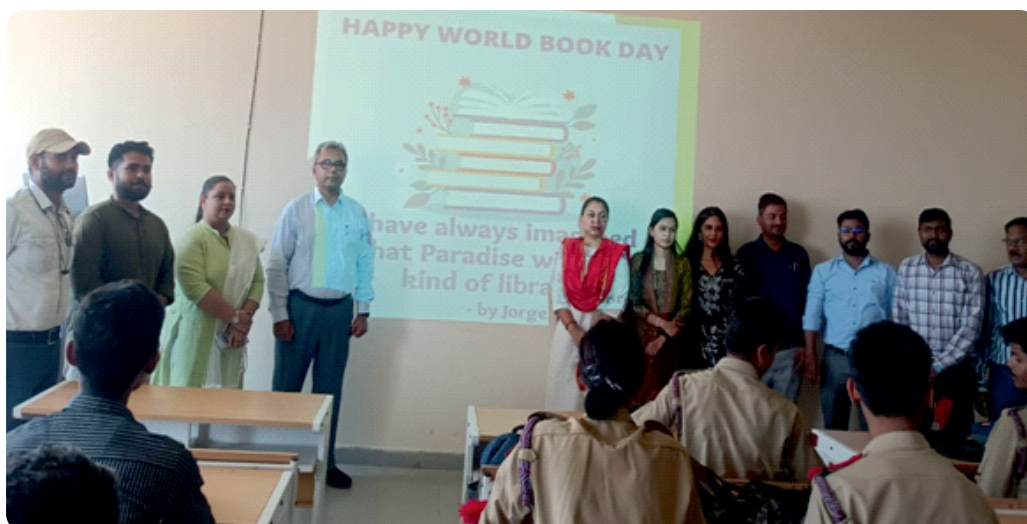
5-Day International Workshop on “Ethics in Scientific Publications”

Agri-Startup Awareness Session Organized at Mangalayatan University

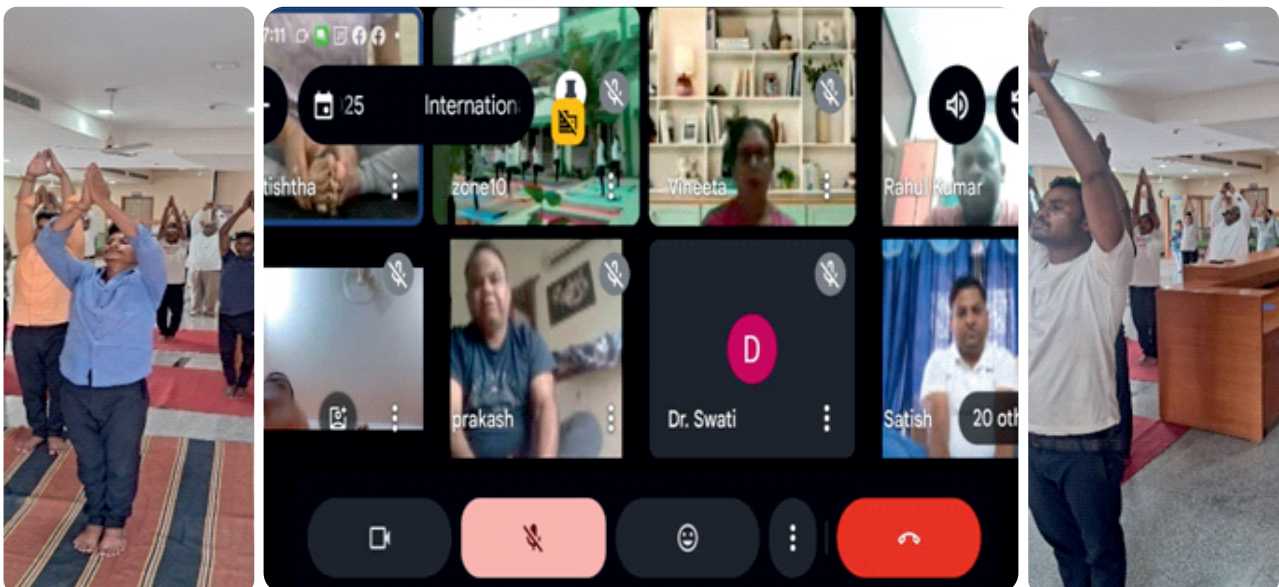

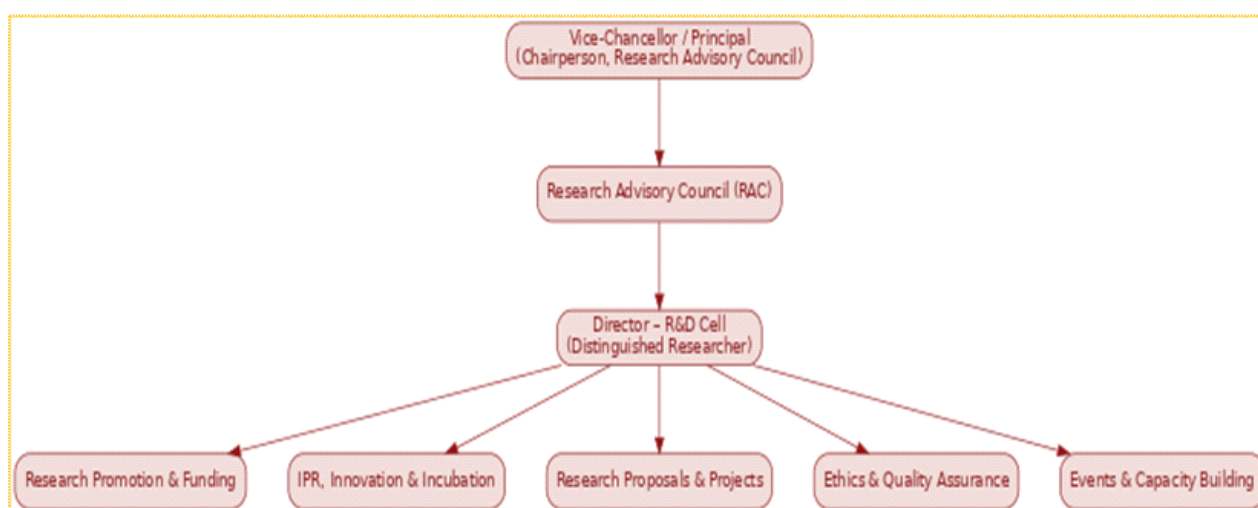
