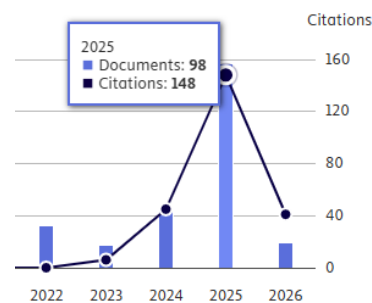

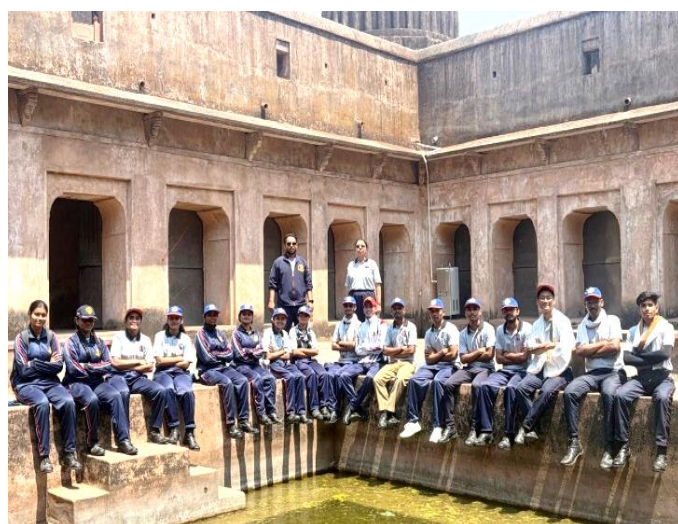
NCC Cadets Arpit Pasi & Tulunga Narzary of Mangalayatan University Jabalpur Participated in PM Rally 2026, New Delhi

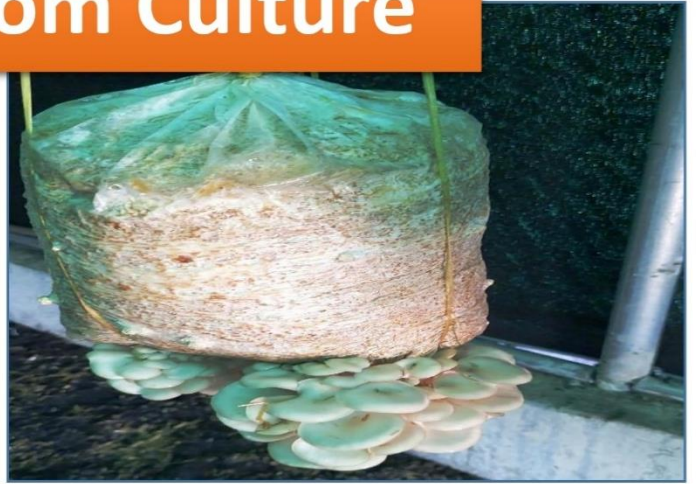

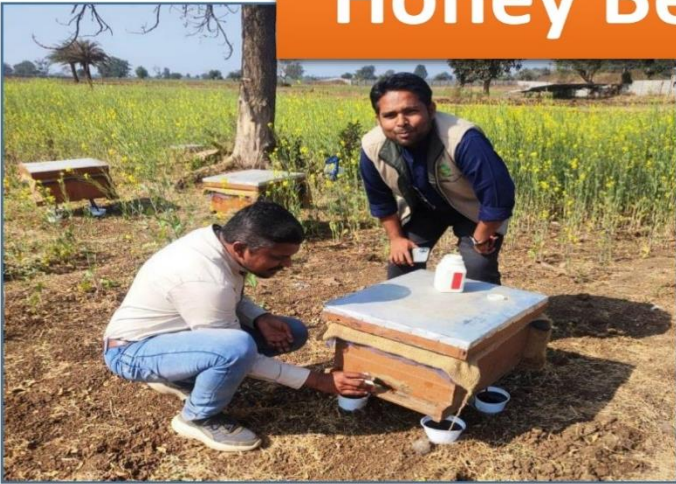
